Group Lessons take place Monday - Thursday. Fridays will be used for make up days in case of inclement weather.

Level 1 - Introduction to Water Skills: Students will learn how to feel comfortable in the water and safely enjoy it.

Level 2 - Fundamentals of Aquatic Skills: Children will learn basic swimming skills.

Level 3 - Stroke Development: Additional guided practice will help students improve their skills.

Level 4 - Stroke Improvement: Kids will gain confidence during swim lessons, improve their stroke and gain additional aquatic skills.

PRIVATE SPLASH PAD PARTY RENTALS

Private Splash Pad Parties get private use of the Splash Pad from 9 am – 10:30 am, and private use of Pavilion #3 directly adjacent to the Splash Pad from 9 am – 11 am. Private Splash Pad Parties are available Wednesday – Sunday.

Fee: \$150 for residents, \$225 for non-residents.

ALL DAY RENTALS

All day rentals are available 7-days a week and include the use of Pavilion #4 by the restrooms (not the pavilion directly adjacent to the Splash Pad).

All day rentals are from 10:30 am - 7:30 pm.



GROUP RENTALS

Group rentals are accepted 7-days a week. Times are 10:30 am – 1:30 pm and 2 pm – 5 pm.

Groups rentals are required for any group with 10 or more members using the Splash Pad. Maximum number of users in a group rental of the Splash Pad is 50.



Before & After Care is provided for families that may need an earlier drop-off time, or a later pickup time. Campers must still register for a Camp Cavins, Camp Choo Choo, or Mini Camp, in addition to Before & After Care. If you are not signed up for day camp or minicamp in addition to Before & After Care, your camper will not be allowed to attend camp. The fee covers both before and after care.

How to Register

Camp registrations can be made online or in-person. Camp fees can be paid in full upon registration or families can utilize our payment plan.

Withdrawal Policy

If you withdraw 15 or more days from the start date of a week of camp, you will receive a 100% of registration fees.

If you withdraw 8-14 days from the start of a week of camp, you will receive a 50% refund of registration fees.

If you withdraw 7 or fewer days from the start date of a week of camp, you will forfeit all registration fees.

Payment Plan Information

There are three ways to pay for camp this summer:

1. Pay in full for all the weeks at registration.

2. Our traditional payment plan, where you pay \$10 down and the remaining balance is due the Monday before your week of camp begings (ex. If you have camp starting on July 7th, you pay \$10 at registration and the balance is due on June 30th). If you wish to use this payment plan, please contact the office prior to registering.

3. Bi-Weekly. You can split your payments up bi-weekly and your balance will be paid off prior to the start of summer camp. This payment plan can be utilized online.
