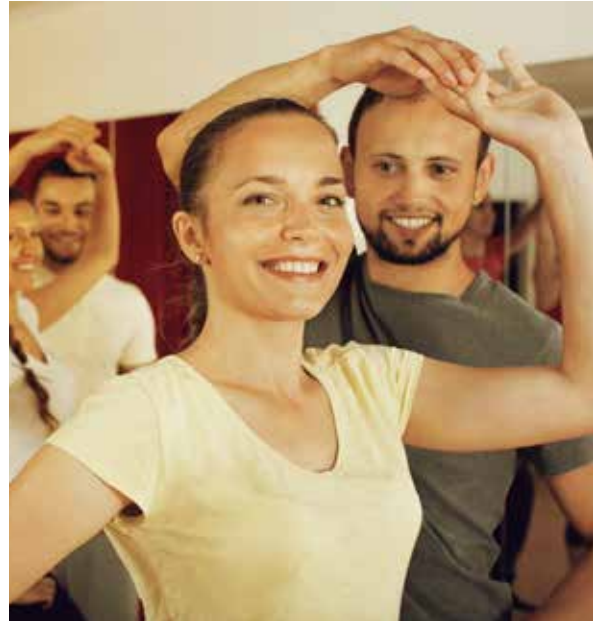

Our swim lessons align with the American Red Cross Learn to Swim Program. Students successfully completing a swim course will receive Red Cross Certification cards.

Group Lessons take place Monday - Thursday. Fridays will be used for make up days in case of inclement weather.

Level 1 - Introduction to Water Skills: Students will learn how to feel comfortable in the water and safely enjoy it.

Level 2 - Fundamentals of Aquatic Skills: Students will learn basic swimming skills.

Level 3 - Stroke Development: Additional guided practice will help students improve their skills.

Level 4 - Stroke Improvement: Students will gain confidence during swim lessons, improve their stroke and gain additional aquatic skills.

Camp Payment Information

How to Register

Summer Camp registration will open in-person and online on Friday, January 2nd at 9am. You can register online at www.ofallonparksandrec.com or in-person at our office at 411 E. Fifth St. O'Fallon, IL 62269. **Please note that there is 3% Credit Card surcharge for both online and in-person credit card transactions.** Payments can be made via cash, credit, debit, or EFT (direct withdrawal from your bank account). Camp fees can be paid in full at registration, or you can sign up using our convenient payment plan. To use our payment plan, you must be either setup to pay using a credit/debit card or EFT.

There are three ways to pay for summer camp this year:

- 1.** You pay for everything in full at the time of registration. **Available online and in-person.**
- 2. Available In-Person Only** - Our traditional payment plan, where you pay \$10 down at registration. The remaining balance is then due the week before your camp begins. Example, if you have camp starting on July June 22nd, you pay the \$10 at registration and the remaining balance comes out on June 15th.
- 3.** Utilize our bi-weekly payment plan. This option splits your payments up bi-weekly and your balance will be paid off by the start of summer camp. **Available online and in-person.**

Bi-Weekly Example – If you sign up on January 5th for five weeks of Camp Cavins your balance is \$650. That balance will then be split across the ten payments dates listed, for a payment of \$65 every two weeks. If you sign up on February 8th for five weeks of Camp Cavins your balance is \$650, but two of the original payment dates would have passed. You are left with the eight remaining payments at \$81.25

Withdrawal Policy

Withdrawals made 15 or more days from the start date of a week of camp, you will receive a 100% refund of the registration fees.

Withdrawals made 8-14 days from the start date of a week of camp, you will receive a 50% refund of the registration fees.

Withdrawals made 7 or fewer days from the start date of a week of camp, you will receive no refund of registration fees.
